

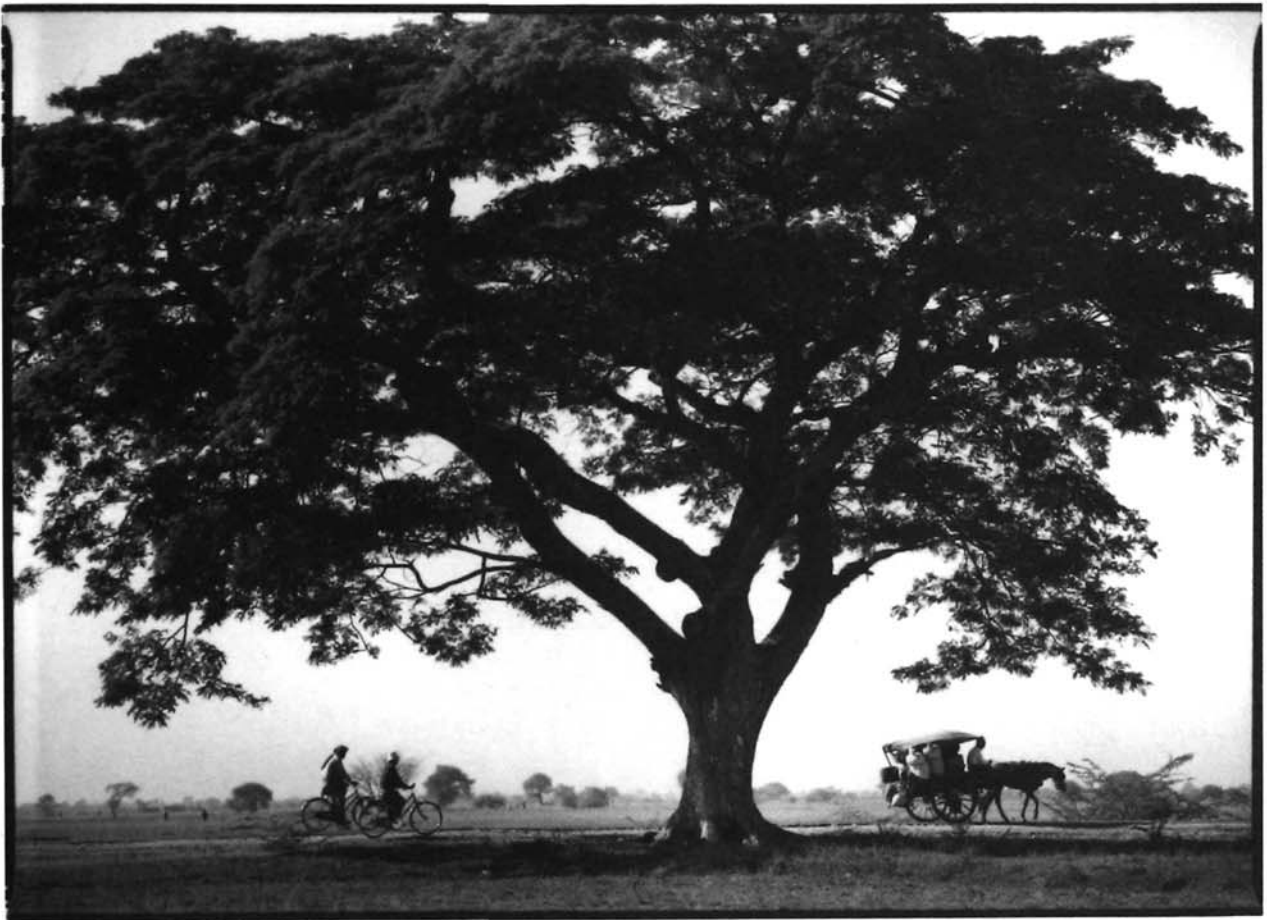
Images of Southeast Asia - a Montage

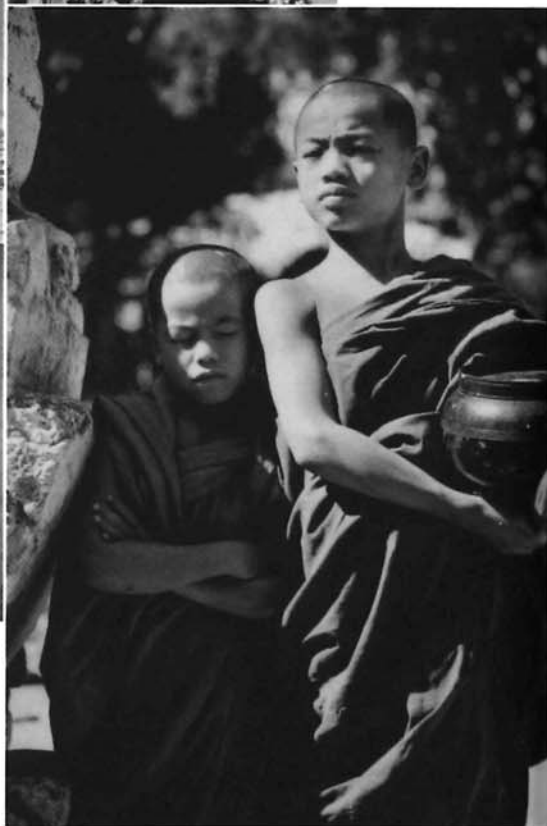

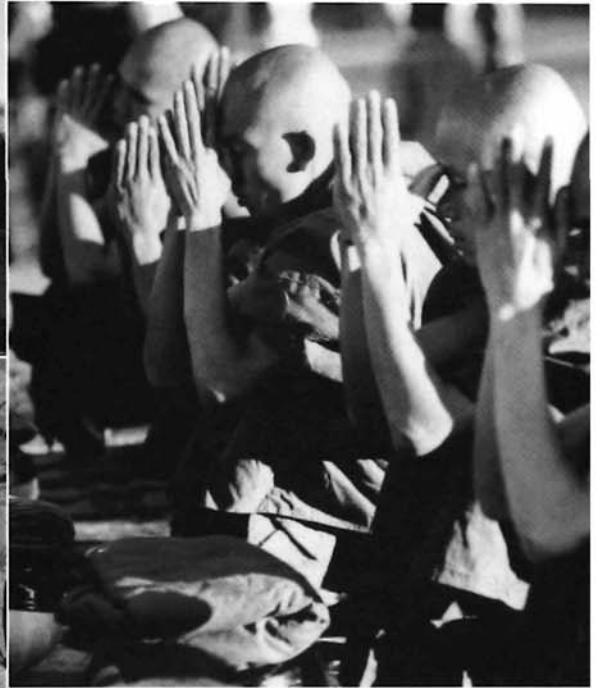

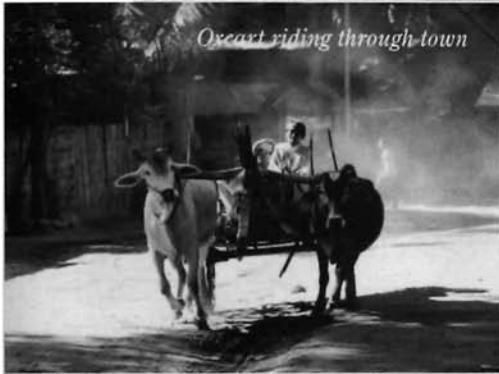

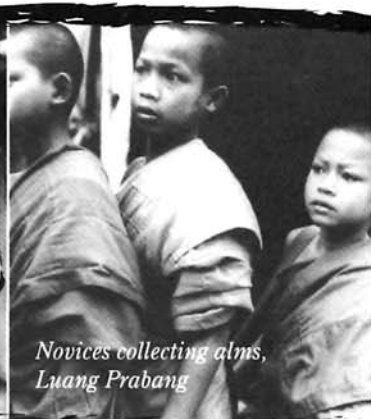

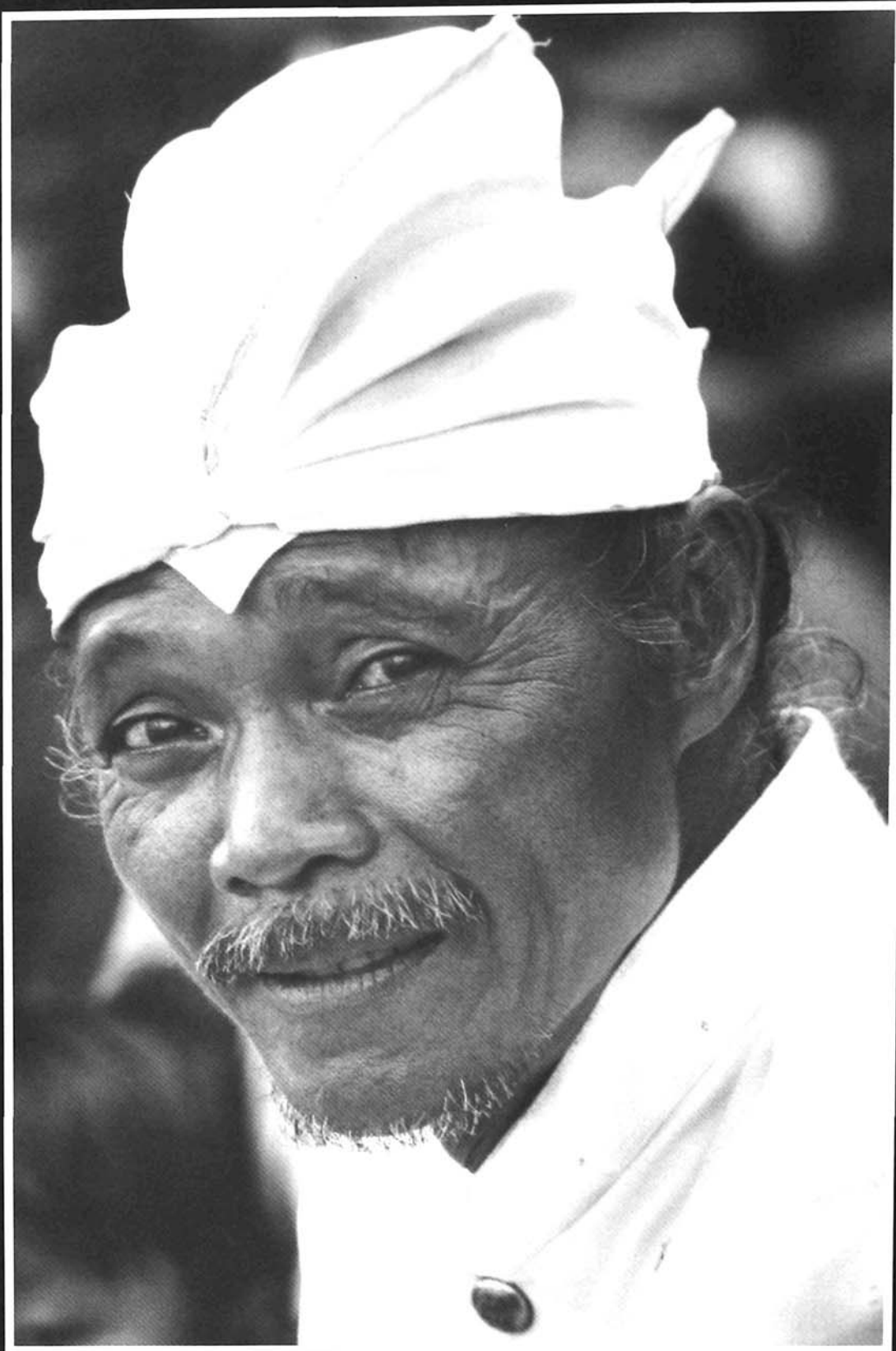

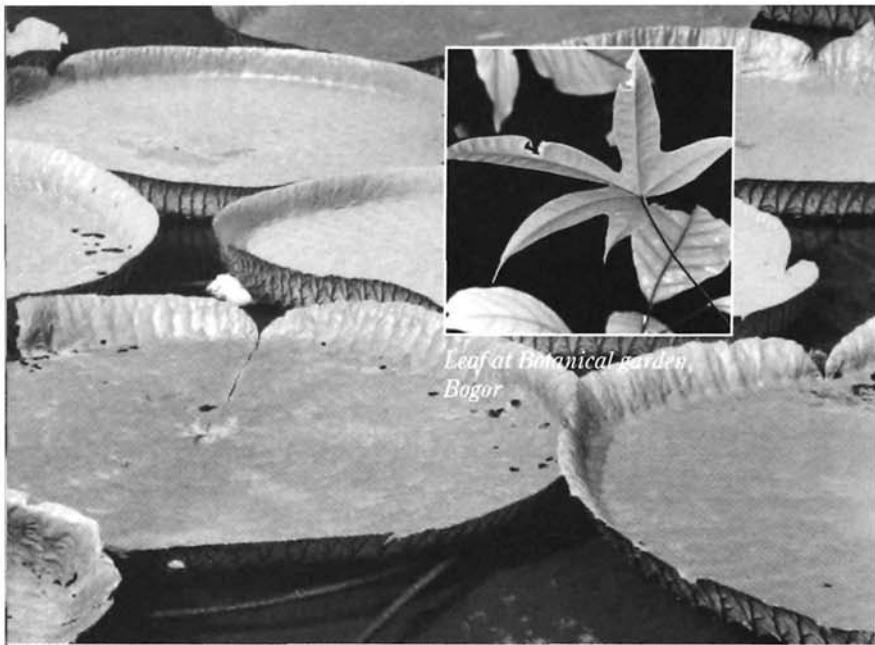

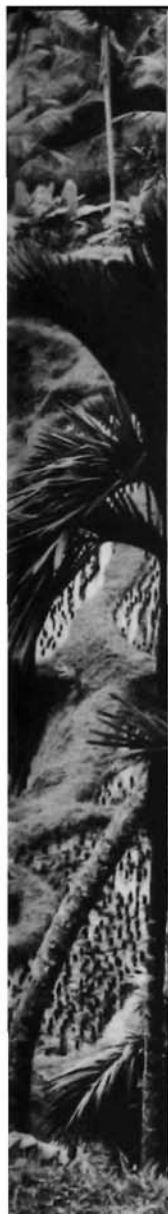

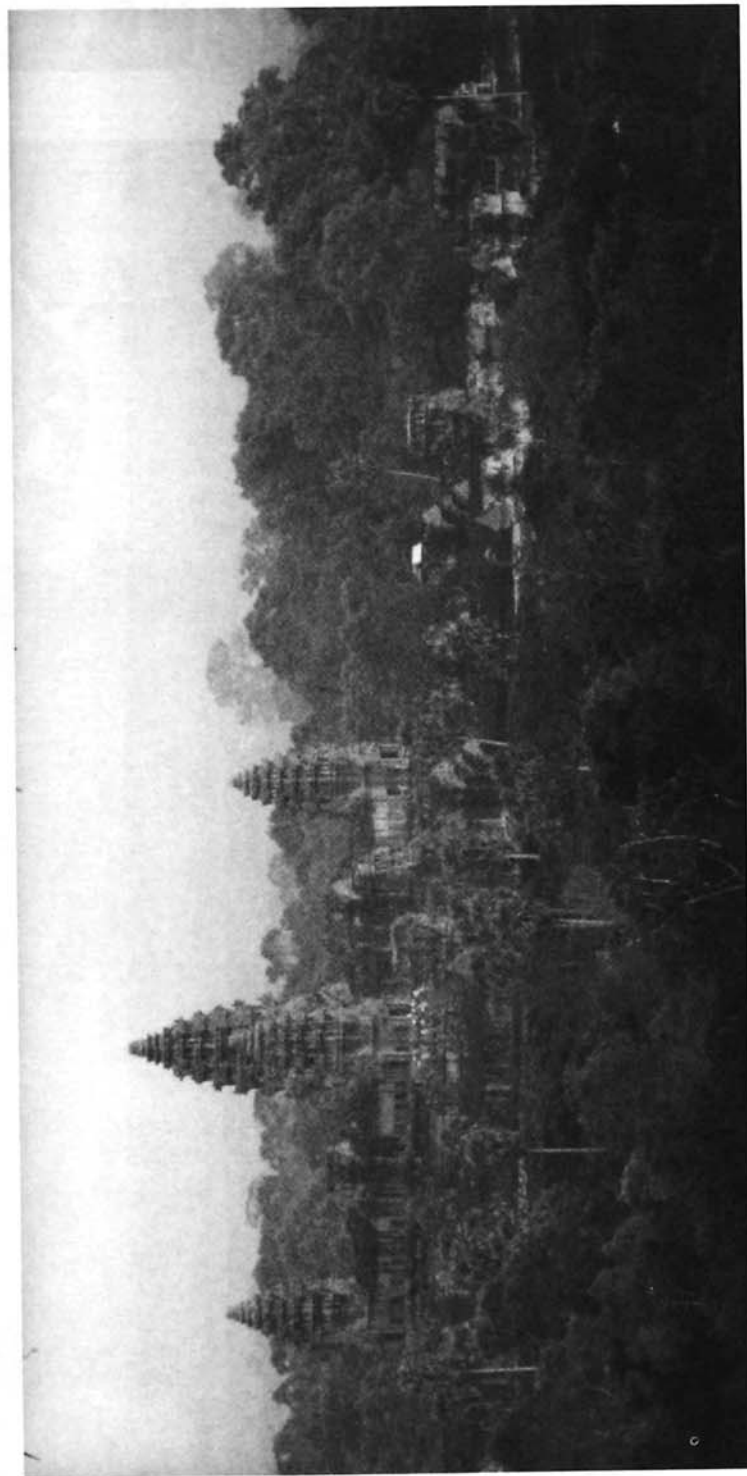

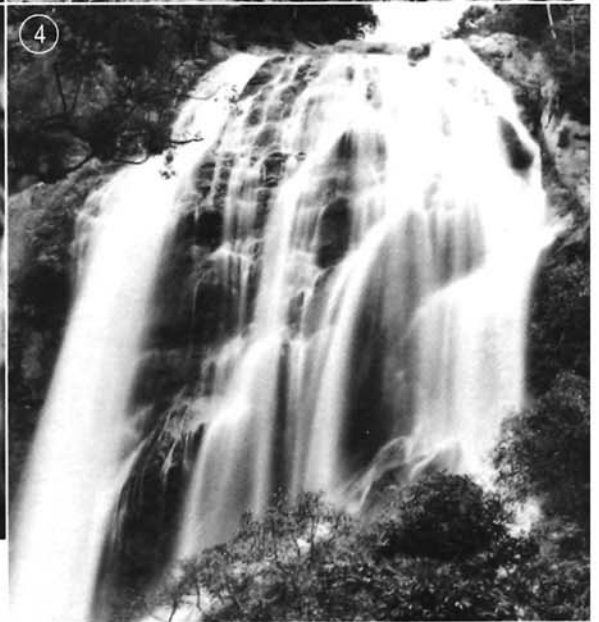
